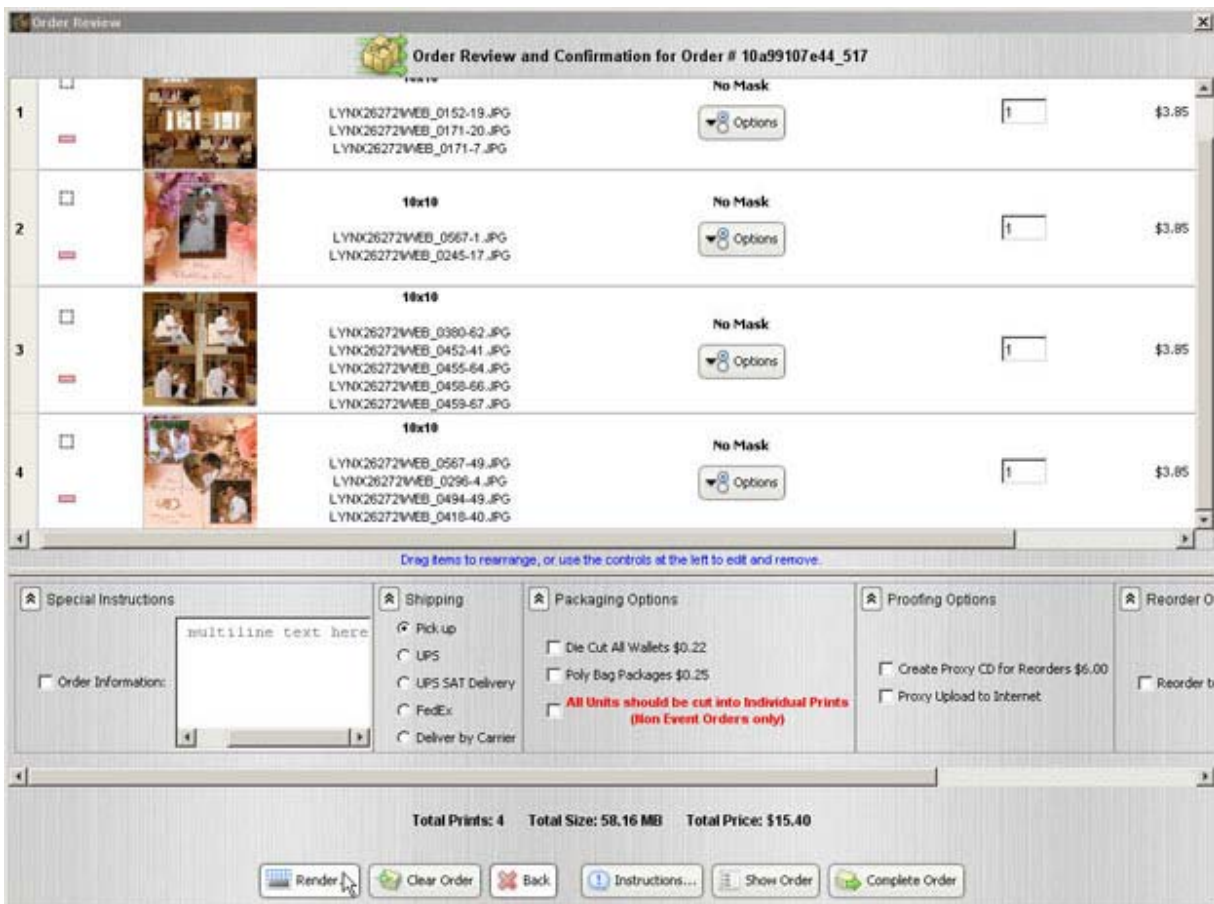


## Render Tool

Working hand in hand with the Presenter Tool, the **Render Tool** converts multi image lay outs to viewable images, allowing your customers to see the 'finished product' before it is actually sent for printing. Layouts can be shown as a presentation, by you, or sent to your customer over the internet. A valuable tool when creating wedding albums to get that final 'okay,' the Render Tool is another easy to use feature of the Image Lynx program.

### Rendering Layouts for Viewing

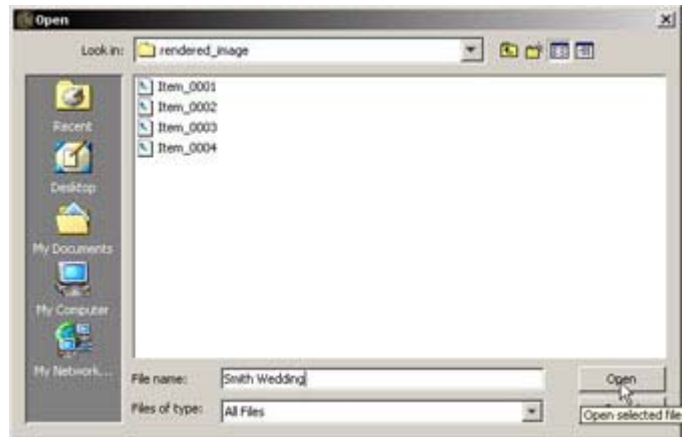
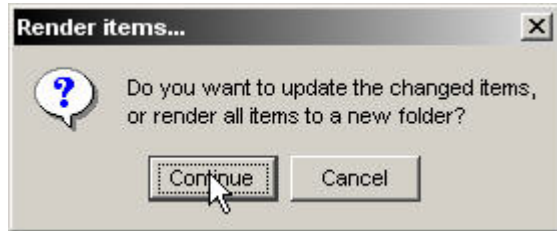


Since the program converts multi image layouts, you must first build your order using either the already available products or products that you have created using the Pager Tool. If you would like to view

the images immediately after you have set up the order, click on the  button, as if you were ready to send the order for printing. When the *Order Review* page has come up, click on the



button. You will be asked to select a folder for the converted images.

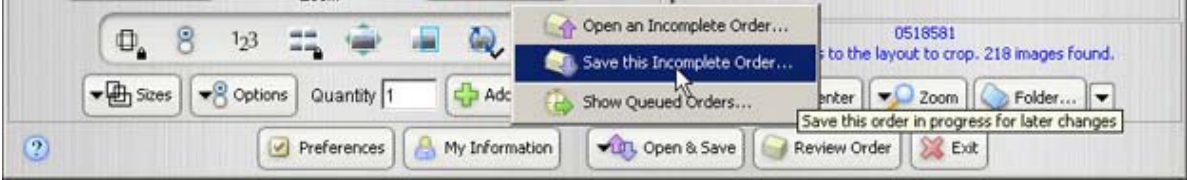


Click **Continue** to select a destination, enter the name and click Open. It is important to give this folder a name specific to its contents so reopening will come easily.



Once Opened, the created layouts set up for the order will be sent to the *Presenter* page.

**Rendering Saved Orders**



If you would like to create an order but will not be viewing it immediately, you can **Save this Incomplete Order** by using the Open & Save button.



When you are ready, open the order from the *Open an Incomplete Order*. Click the **Render** button. As before, your pages will be sent to the Presenter page for viewing. Once on the Presenter page, your viewing options for these images are the same.

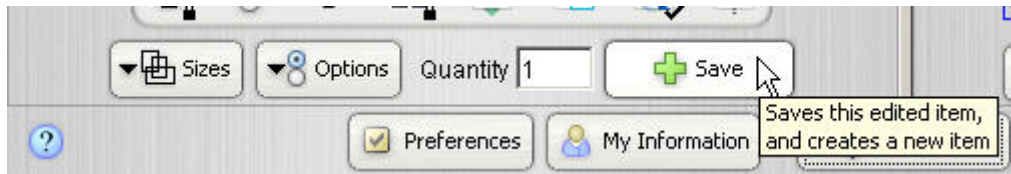
## Editing the Pages



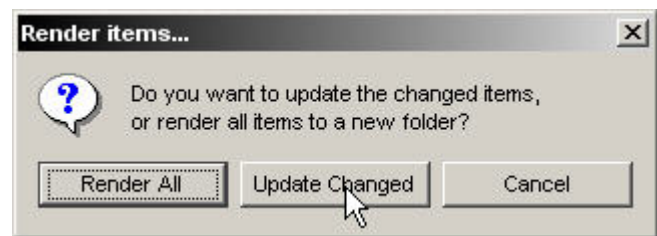
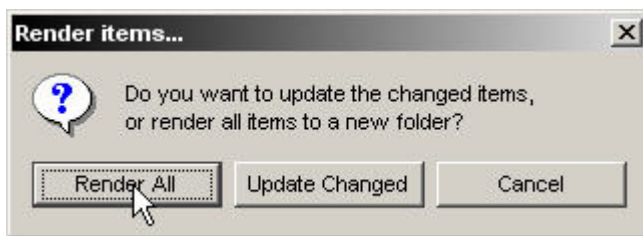
The Render tool gives you and your customer the chance to see the final outcome before it has been printed. This allows you to make changes to the layouts if you or your customers are not satisfied with the product. The process will be simpler if you allow your customer to view the layouts and make notes as to what they like, and what they would like changed.



Once they have made their decisions, you will need to **Close** the *Presenter* page, returning you to the Review Order page. Once there, click on the edit box next to the layout that needs adjusting. This takes you back to the Image Lynx page where you can make the necessary changes.



When completed, click **Save**, and Review Order. Continue until you have filled all of your customers requests or made the changes you thought were required. If you would like to view their pages again before sending the order, click the Render button.



You will be asked if you would like **Render All** or **Update Changed**. If you choose to *Render All*, you will then be asked to select a new folder. Selecting *Update Changed* immediately reopens the *Presenter* pages with the newly adjusted images. The update may take a few seconds – don't panic! If the pages are now acceptable, you can close the *Presenter* and **Complete Order!**

## Sending Images to Your Customer for Viewing

If it is not possible for your customer to view the layouts at your studio, you can now, since they have been converted to single images, send them to your customer. These are not printable images so your customer will not be able to do anything to them but see how beautiful they are. Remember the name you created for these images? From that folder, you will need to send each of the items individually. If you have created five pages and are sending via an email, compose you letter, and choose to attach files. You will have to Browse and select and attach **each image**. Sending the entire folder will result in your customer receiving text that they do not understand, which refers to their pictures, but looks not near as nice! Practicing this once or twice is not out of the question.

## Rendered Image Files are NOT Printable

Please remember that the rendered pages are not the images from which your items will be printed. Unlike the *Presenter*, you cannot send the thumbnails to the LYNX thumbnail area and drop them into a product. The pages you have set up should be sent from the order you created, either by going back to the review page or by opening the saved order in the queue.
